Recording Instructions for Form B2

General Instructions:

1. Form B2 is for recording the flushing or importation of embryos for embryo transfer.
2. The recording forms are self carboning. Recording should be neat and made firmly so that your second copy is also clear.
3. Mail the top copy of the B2 Form together with registration fees, copy of pedigree and details of DNA for Sire and Dams to the Registrar at ABRI within 180 days of flush or importation.
4. File the second copy and associated paperwork for future reference.
5. DNA profile and parent verification is required for all cattle put forward for registration unless already on file.
6. Only DNA profile is required for all cattle registered with ABCS prior to 26.11.2005.

Recipient Tattoo No.	Use your herd ident and an ear tag number for the cow eg. ABC123
Recipient Breed code	Breed of Cow used as recipient. Code you will find at back of Regulations under Standard Breed Codes

Breeder or owner (Nominated member) to sign and date form and forward to Registrar at ABRI with appropriate fees and documentation within 180 days of flush or importation
